A Curtain Raiser to Health Zone

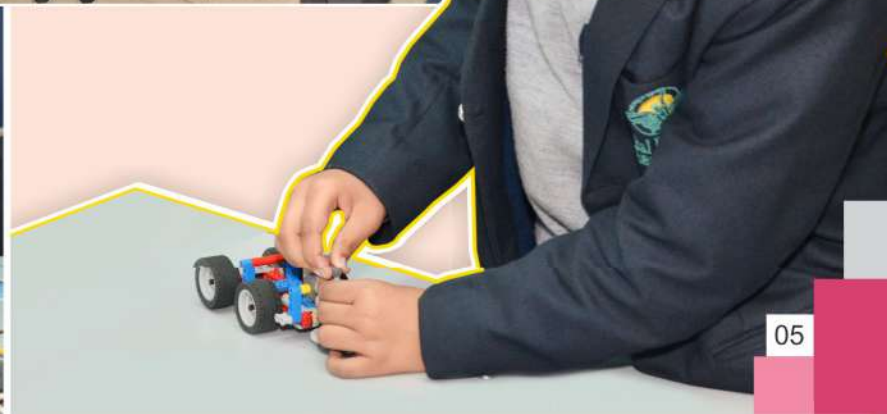

Class VI students participated in activity 'Yoga - The Way of Life' and learnt about the impact of Yoga on mind, physique and spirit by practising some Yogasanas.



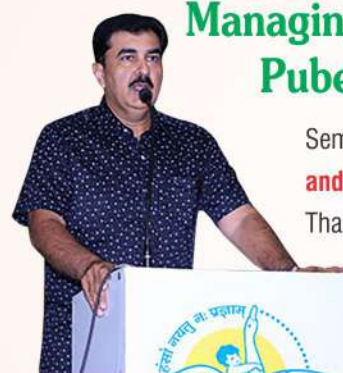
SEMINAR ON

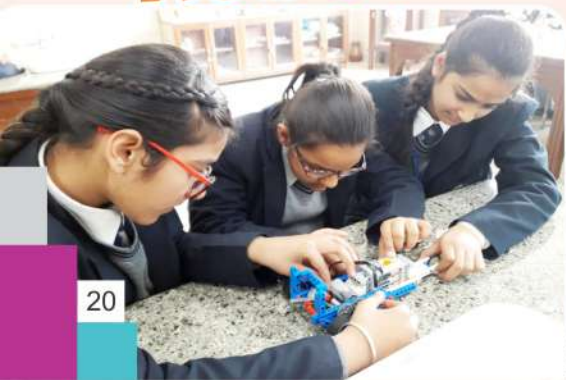
