

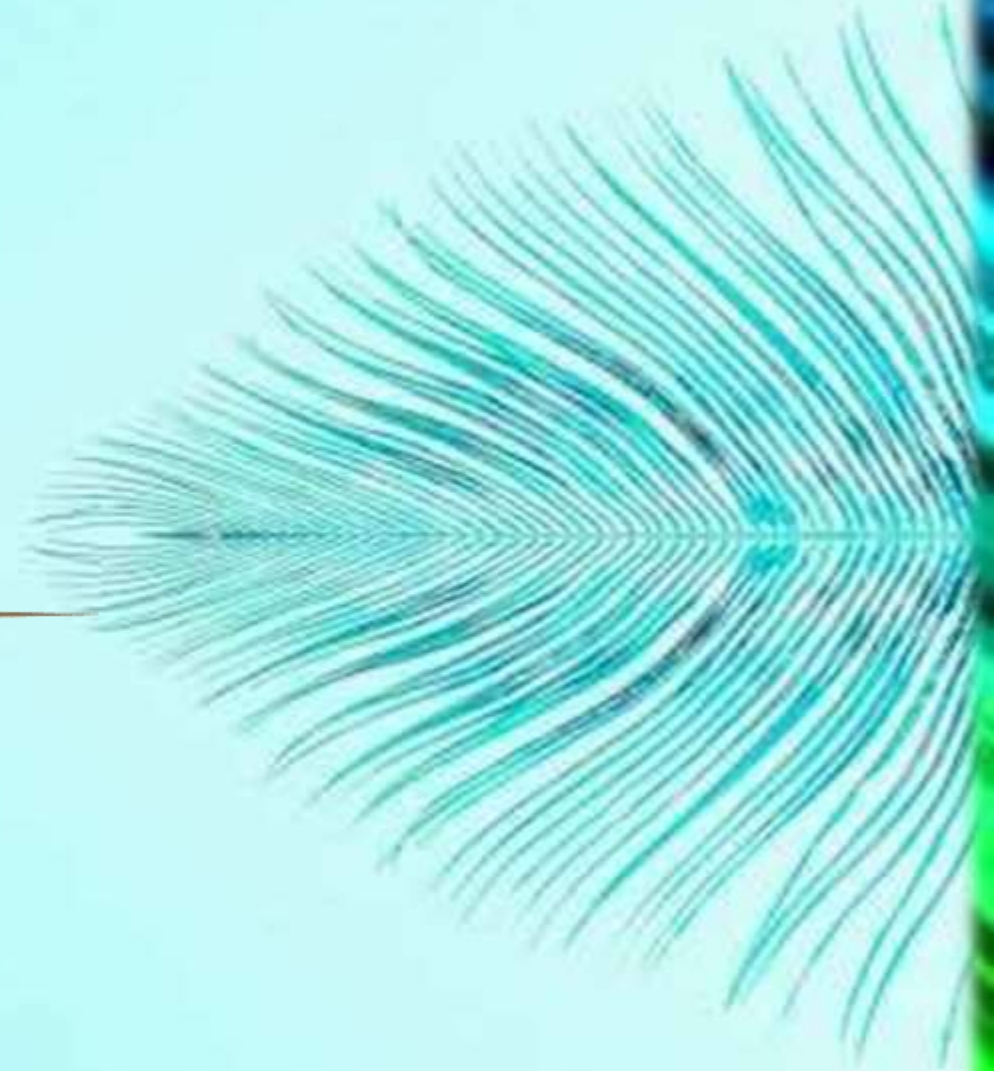

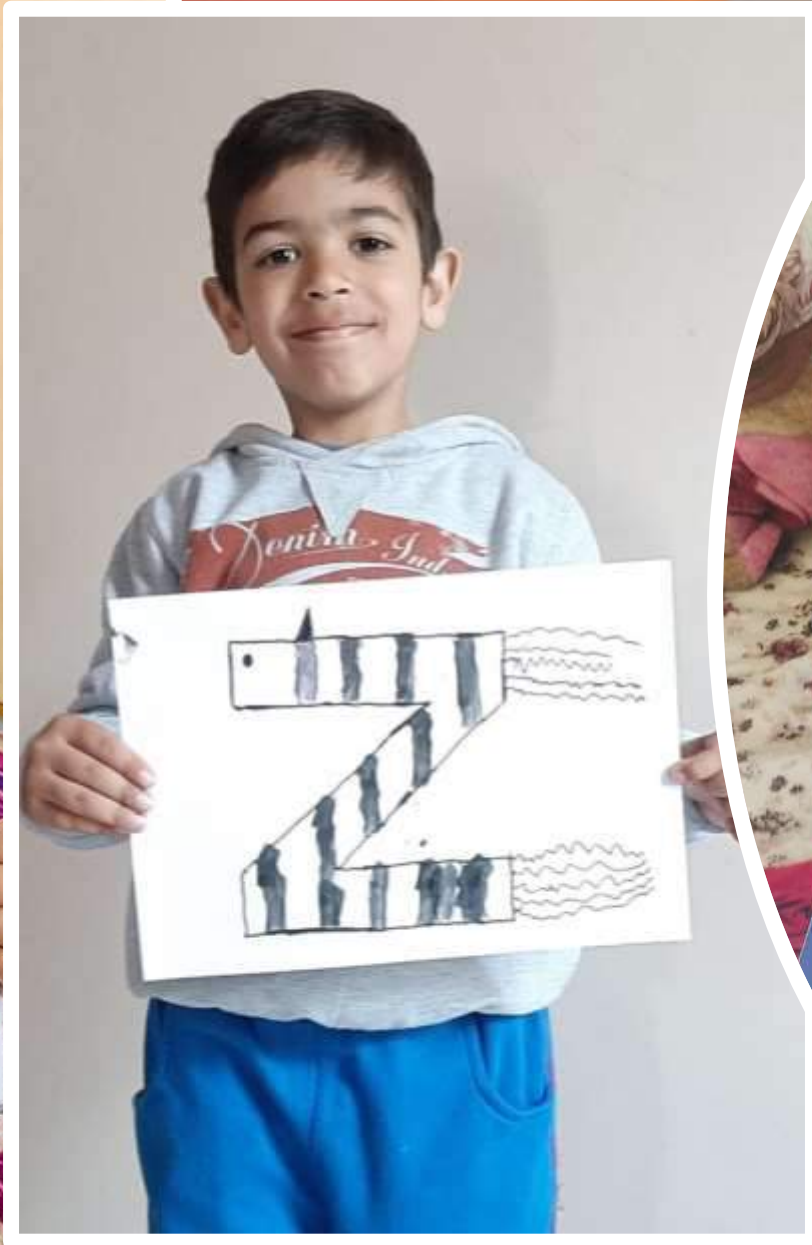
# *Pre-Primary Department*

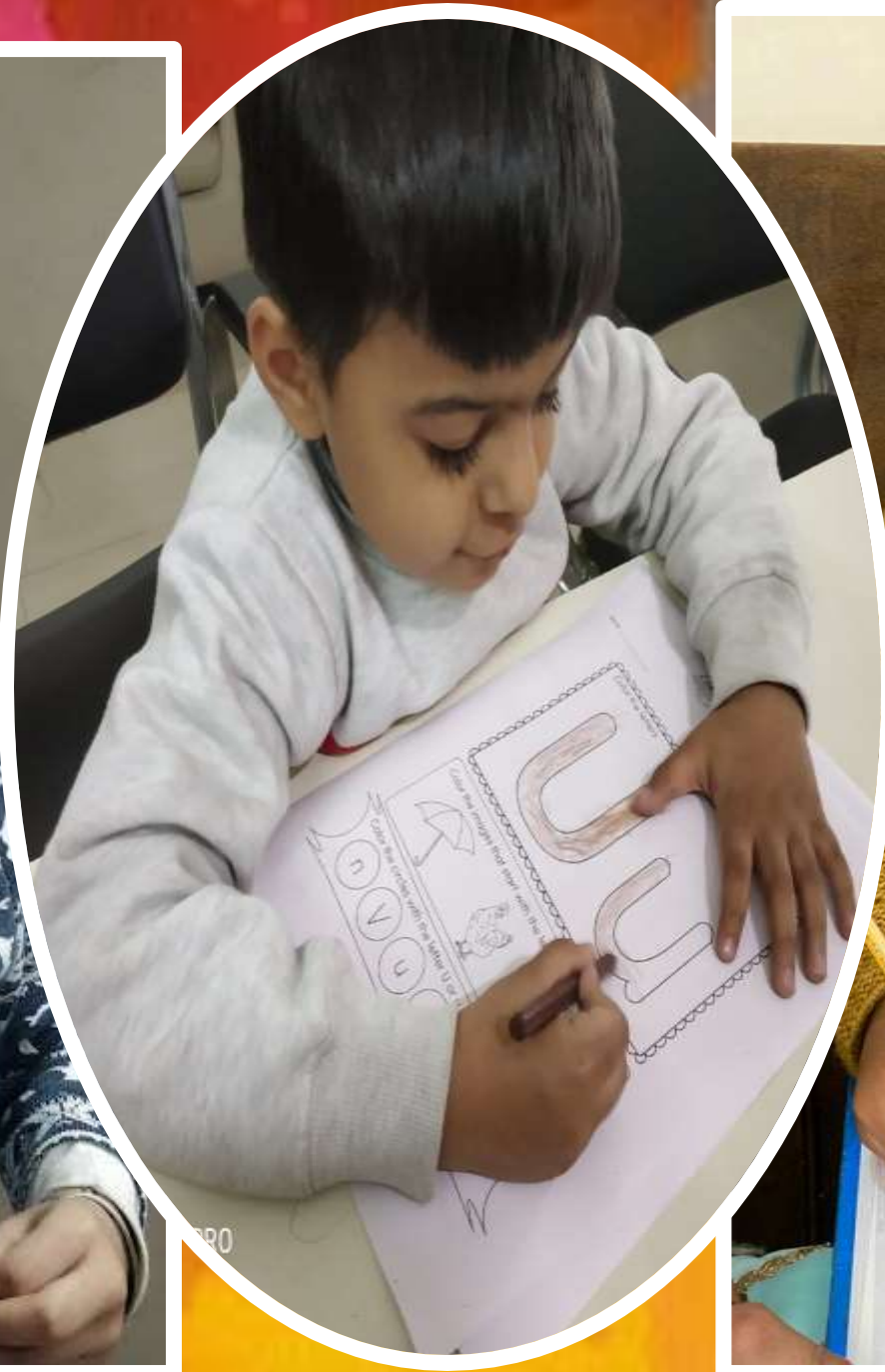


- Children were involved in activities that focus on improving the oratory skills.

- Ensuring the enthusiasm, the school has made virtual classrooms interactive where children have fun with their classmates virtually which is part of daily sessions.

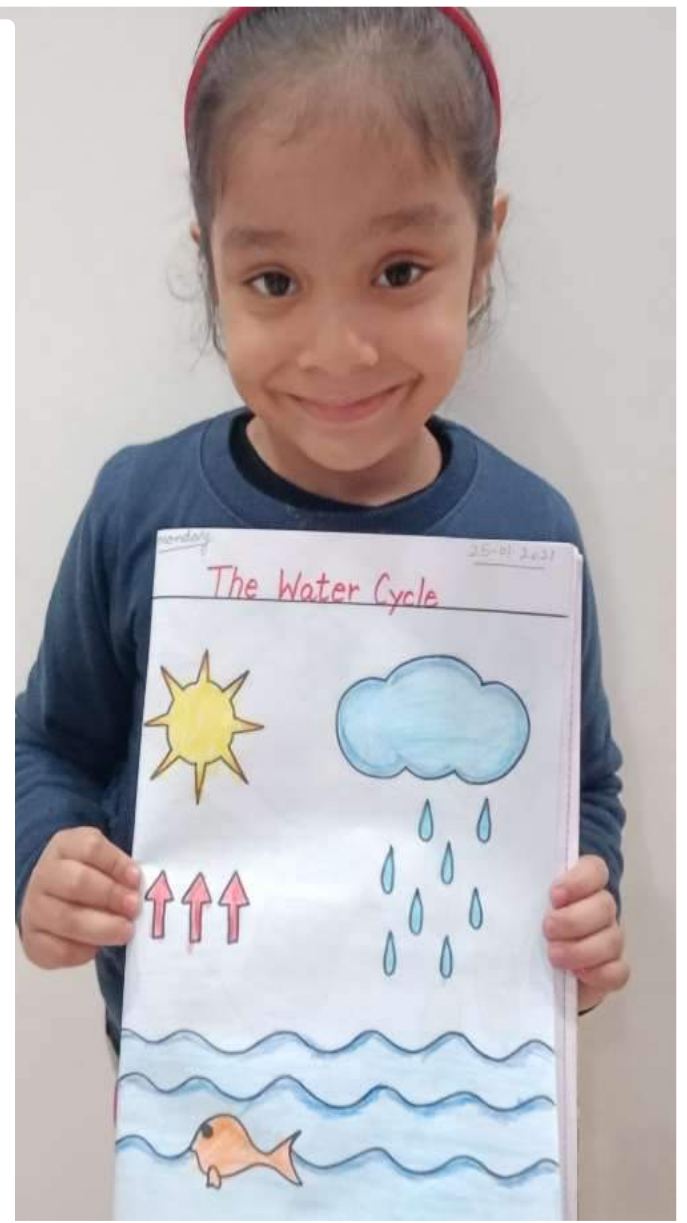
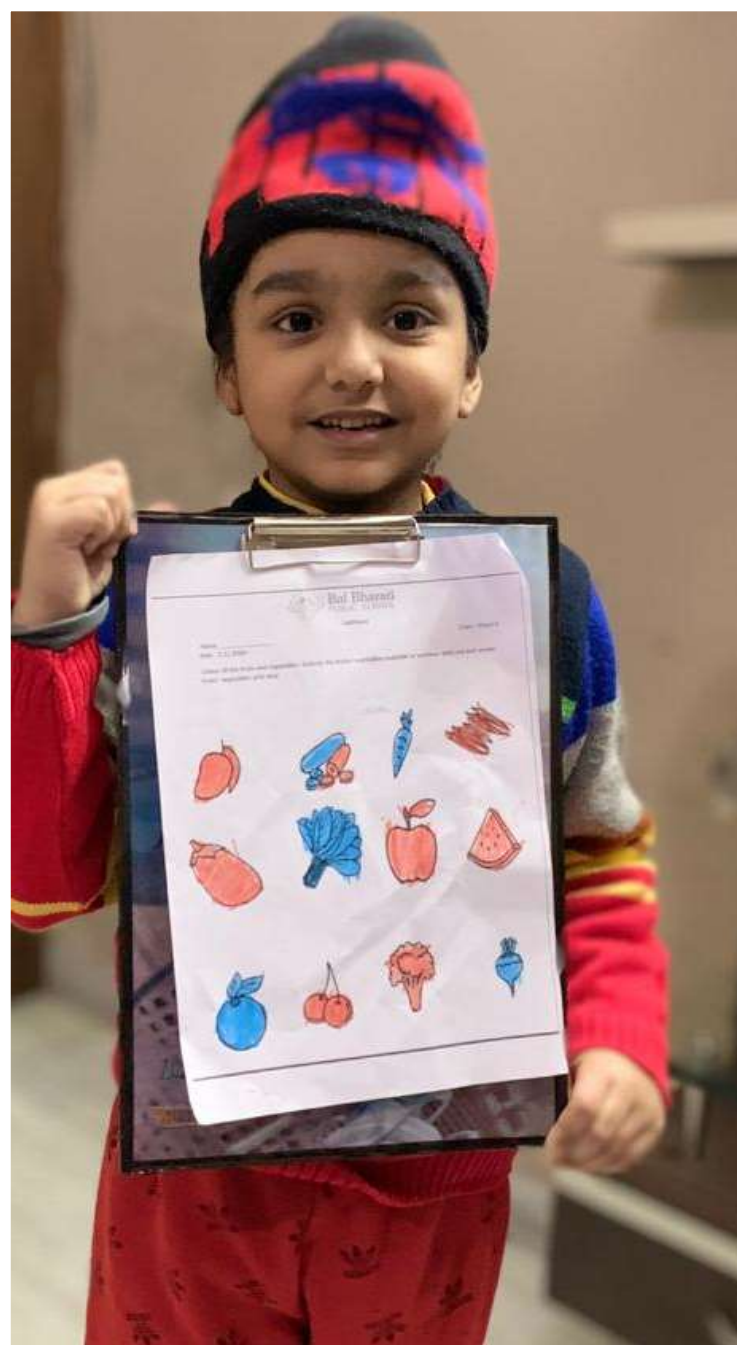














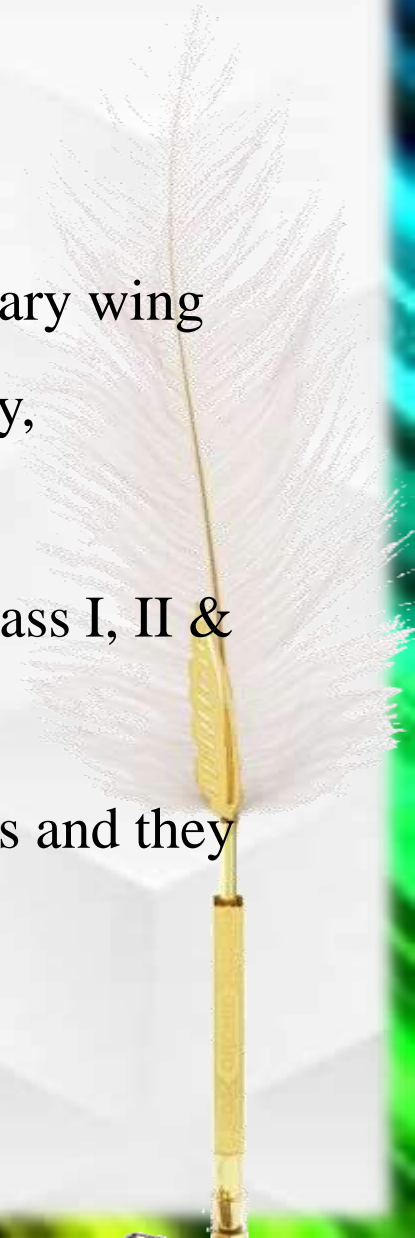




# *Primary Department*

- School started in offline mode for the students of Class IV – V on 12 Feb.2021 and Class I, II & III on 20 Feb.2021 to revise the concepts taught during online classes .
- PTM was held with the parents to apprise them with the academic status of their wards and they were guided to lend a helping hand to bring improvement in performance.

- Offline Examination schedule was shared with the parents .
- Approximately 70--75% students appeared for the exams.
- Proper revision and extra class schedule was framed and children were provided with plenty of revision worksheets and question banks for each subject.







# *Senior wing*



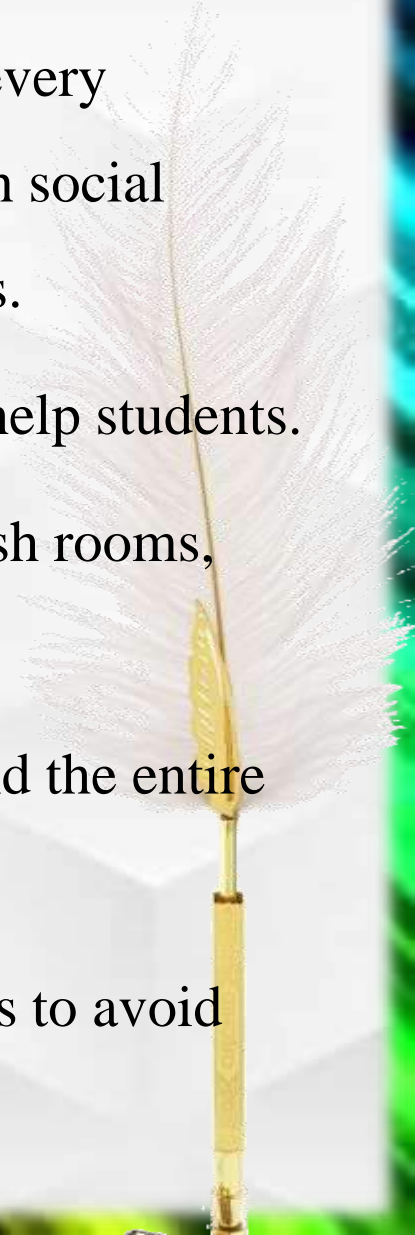
In senior wing, conducting exams in offline mode for IX to XII in January 2021 was planned in following stages:

1. Parents were shared the protocol to be followed in school with respect to various precautions/safety measures being taken in school in view of COVID-19.
2. Date sheet was planned in order to have staggered strength of students in school.
3. All safety and health protocols were followed and robust hygiene regime was maintained.
4. All guidelines including distance norms were followed while planning, only 12 students were seated in a room.





5. All seating arrangements were posted to student and parents groups a day prior to every examination so that the child reaches his / her assigned room directly without much social interaction with other students in the corridors or other parts of the school premises.
6. Also list of students to be seated in a room was duly displayed outside the room to help students.
7. Regular (hourly) sanitation of common contact surfaces like taps, door handles, wash rooms, railings was done.
8. After every examination each and every desk and room was thoroughly sanitised and the entire process was duly monitored.
9. Dispersal of students was also planned in a staggered manner through multiple gates to avoid overcrowding. The intimation of the same was given to parents well in advance.







**The school got an overwhelming response of 98% attendance.**

A similar process was followed for conducting offline Prefinals for VI to VIII.

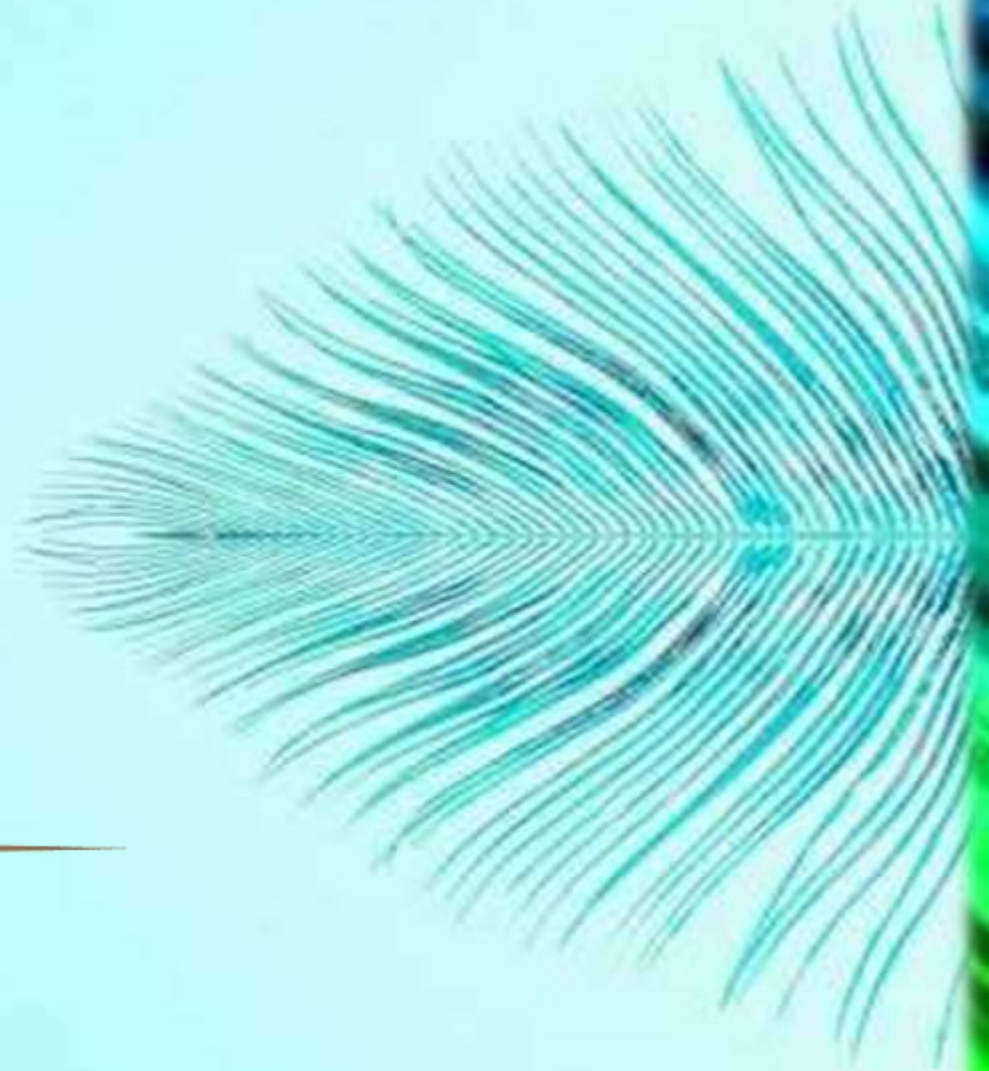
- The school successfully adapted a blended learning model with a mix of online and offline classes for the students .
- A hybrid system of classes was followed wherein online classes were given in a way that the students not coming to school may not miss on content done in class.
- Presently Annual exams are being conducted for Class VI to IX and XI and Common Pre boards for Classes X and XII.
- The Pre boards were over on 15 March 2021, now the schools are again closed till 31 March, 2021 as per guidelines of Punjab Govt.

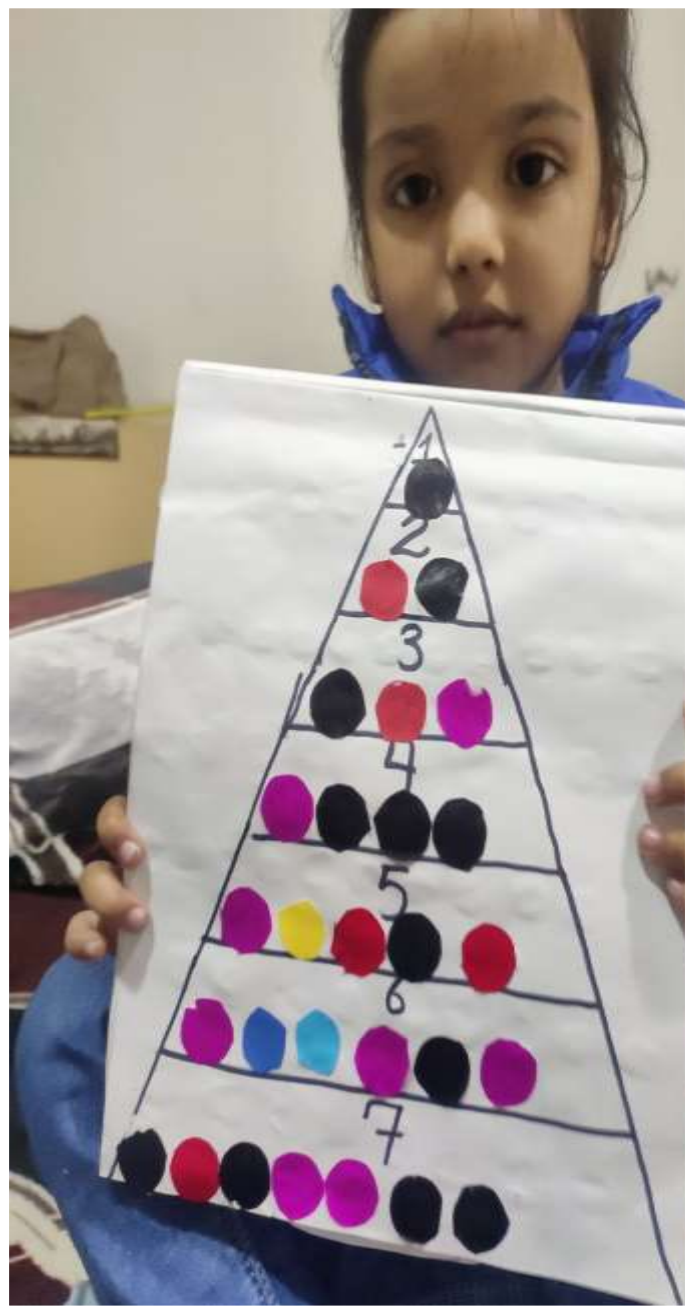

# *Christmas Celebrations*



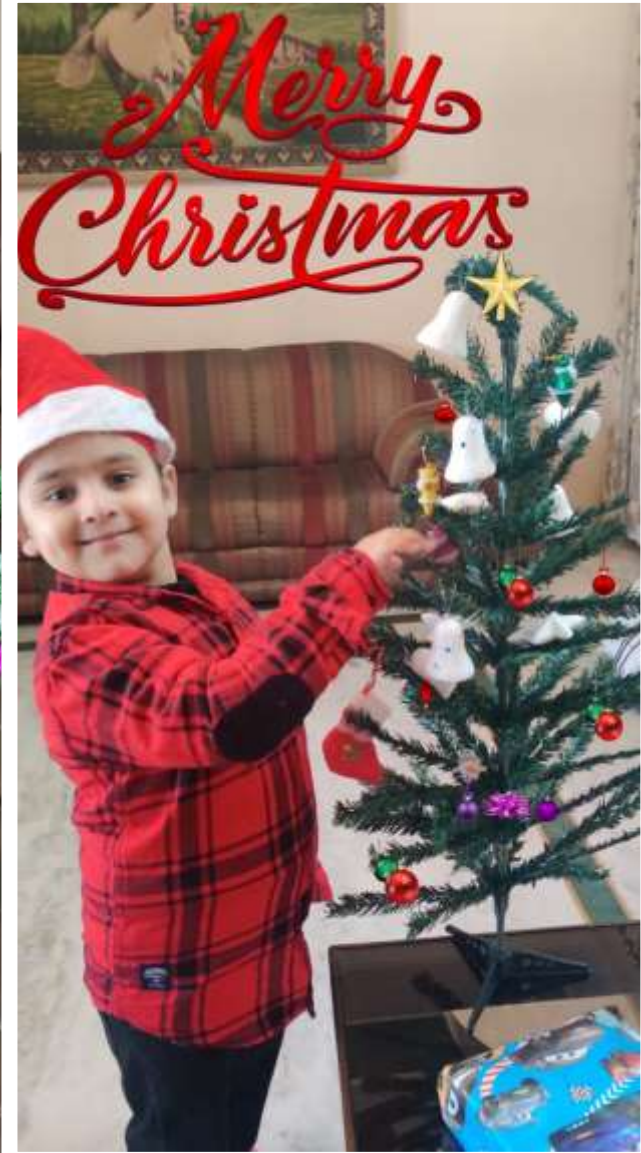
- Christmas was celebrated spreading the message of love & joy.
