- The main objective of the session was to acquaint the children with the terms and fundamentals of Soilless farming.

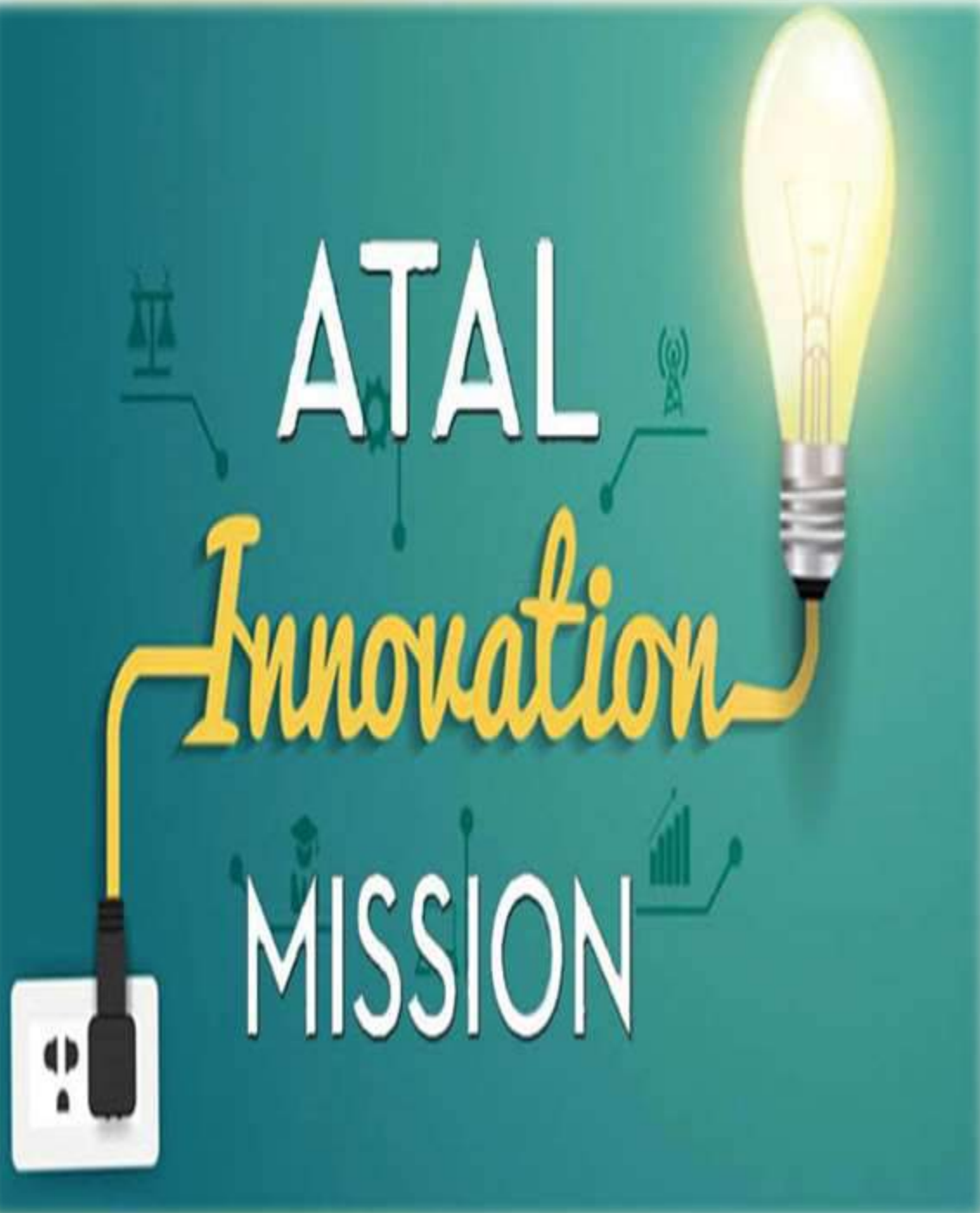

Rise of Dictators - After WW-I
Adolf Hitler was an Austrian-born German politician who was the dictator of Germany from 1933 to 1945. He rose to power as the leader of the Nazi Party. Becoming Chancellor in 1933 and Führer in 1934. He went to jail for 9 months. He was born on 20 April 1889 and died on 30 April 1945.

Emperor Hirohito of Japan was the 124th and the longest-reigning monarch of Japan. He was the leader of Japan in the second world war. There were 7 children of Hirohito. He was succeeded by his eldest son, Akihito. He was born on 29 April 1901 and died on 7 January 1989. He was responsible for Japan's attack on Pearl Harbor in World War II.

Berito Mussolini was an Italian politician and a journalist. He was born on 29 July 1888.

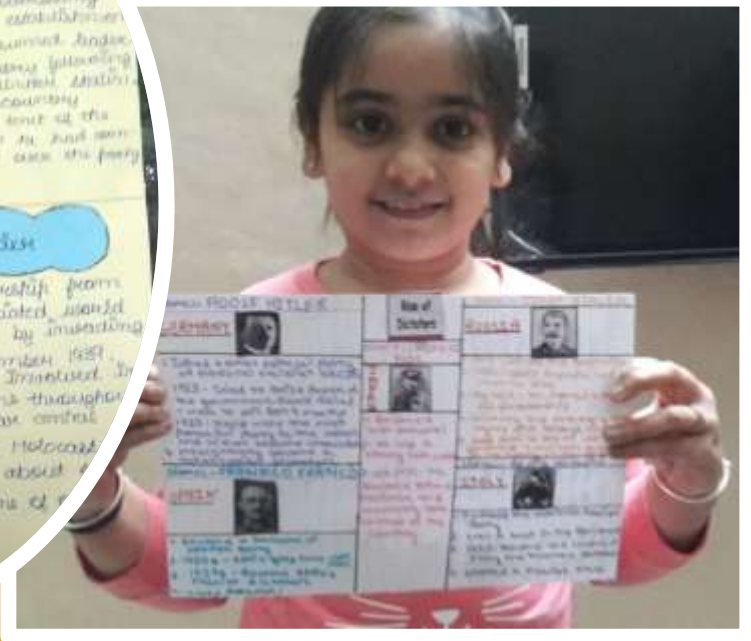


Joseph Stalin
