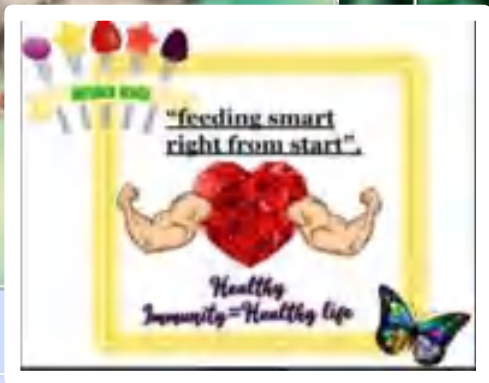




National Nutrition Week

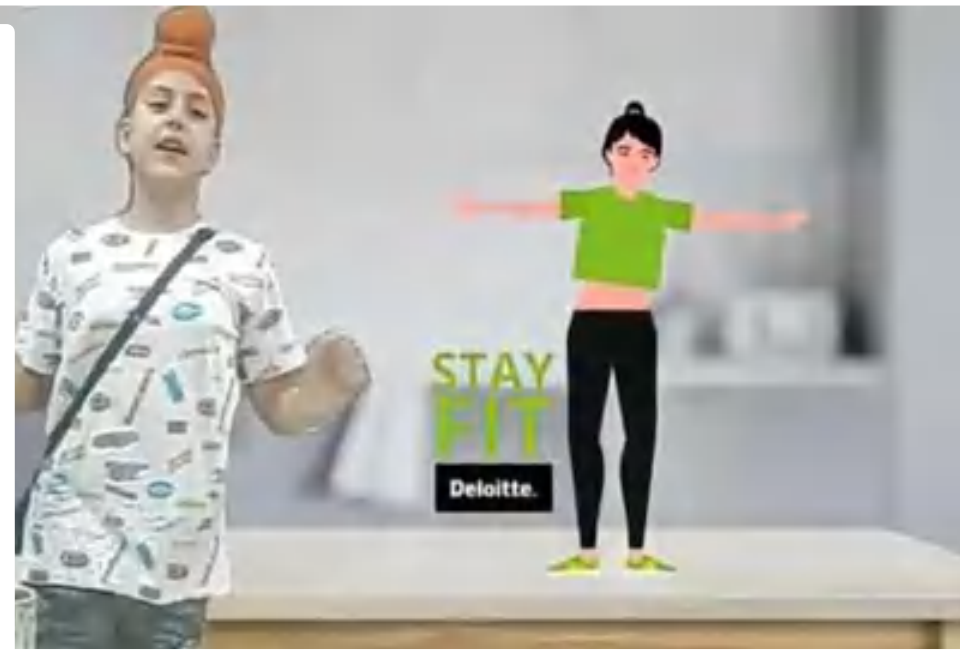

- This activity enabled the students to develop their practical as well as scientific skills . More than 40 students participated in this activity.

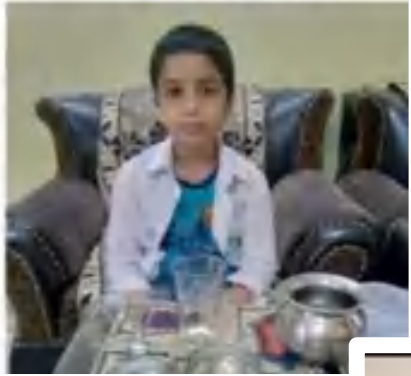
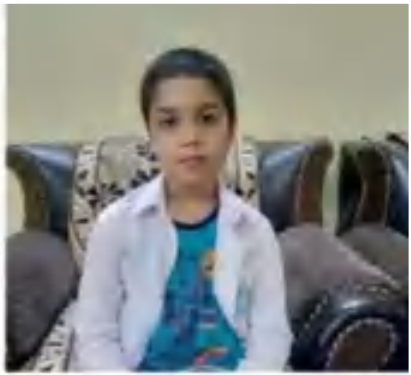

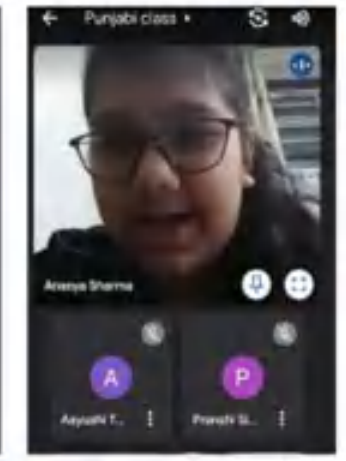




Cyclone
