Research Methodology

The objective of this research was to arrive at a list of top schools in **Tricity (Chandigarh, Mohali, Panchkula) and Ludhiana**. The study had three major sections: **Desk Research, Perceptual survey & Factual data survey**. The collection of data was done through **Primary Research**. A **PERCEPTUAL SURVEY** was used to measure and score the various academic parameters that participated in the study and rank them accordingly.



Study was conducted across two zones in Tricity (Chandigarh & Mohali) & Ludhiana

The **interviews** of respondents who were interviewed were made of the school principals based on their experience with the current school and their perception with respect to other schools in the region.

The survey was conducted during the week of September to the week of October 2021.

SCENARIO 2 | DESK RESEARCH - IDENTIFYING LIST OF SCHOOLS

This method is used to identify research needs, to compare the list of schools was prepared with the help of internet, magazines and other publications.

The various sources used for generation of school list included:

- Schools following CBSE, ICSE, etc. curriculum
- List of school from previous survey
- Direct communication with various groups in the same district
- Direct communication with various groups in the same district
- Direct communication with various groups in the same district

Schools that have at least 5 batches as of April 2021.

Schools that have been in existence for at least 5 years.

As it is not possible to get a complete list of schools and include them in the survey, we had to opt for adding only few school names in the survey form if our respondent mentioned any school name, we had to list it differently every school had a chance of getting included in the survey if their name was mentioned by the respondent.

MORNING 2 | FACTUAL SURVEY

More than 100 schools were called the factual questionnaire for EEIing regarding the quality and the high results followed up through telephone.

The factual data sheet focuses on the following information aspects:

- General information of the school: Establishment, Affiliation etc.
- Infrastructure & Facilities: Sports facilities in the school, Cultural/extra-curricular facilities in the school
- Medium of teaching in the school
- Teachers
- Exchange programs and global exposure
- Awards

MORNING 3 | PERCEPTUAL SURVEY

A perceptual questionnaire was administered to 200 respondents. Respondents were asked to rate 200 of the top 1000 schools based on their perception.

and had included them in their list of top schools in their area. Respondents were asked to evaluate the schools & rate on a scale of 1 to 5 where 1 means poor & 5 means excellent. The list of parameters covered in the survey was arrived at based on past surveys as well as discussion with experts from the industry experts and teachers etc. As mentioned, different stakeholders were taken into consideration for the perceptual survey viz. Teachers, Alumni, Students, Parents.

NEEDLE IN A HAYSTACK & FINAL RANKING OF SCHOOLS

In this model, importance weights were calculated using regression model for each of the parameters based on analysis of both factual data & perceptual data scores. Further analysis was done to arrive at the final score for each of the schools. The overall index score for a school was arrived at by equal weighting to their perceptual and factual score. Based on the performance on the overall index score, final ranking was done in response category.

SOME CHALLENGES/SHORTCOMINGS

- Not all schools were able to reach every school in the region, however, any school that did not respond to the survey was not included in the survey.
- The schools principals who have responded to the survey have been included in the survey.
- If the data from any school is found very low, both schools are treated as one.
- The schools/principals who have shared their feedback questionnaire, were asked to give a 5 star rating and a overall ranking of the school.
- Some schools are relatively newer schools and have less than 5 batches passed out for Class X.
- Some schools may have been closed in perceptual survey were not able.
- The perceptual rankings are based on shared information. Avance Research undertakes reasonable measures to get complete set of data before making decision. Pre- Primary – Ms. Nanu Rekhi



- Ms. Nanu Rekhi Ma'am, Advisor, Academic Council, CES, New Delhi, visited BBPS Ludhiana from 16th December to 18th December '21. An introductory session was organized on 16.12.21 for the teachers of Pre-Nursery, PS, PP, in-charges of class I, II and facilitators of Sunshine World.
- It involved multiple sessions ranging from current curriculum & pedagogical practices, class & activities observations etc.
- Details of new Pre – Primary curriculum adopted by CES since 2018-19 were shared along with details of learning modules prepared under her guidance at CES.
- Details covered also included changes accepted as per NEP & NIPUN besides these sessions on appraisal strategy in reference to learning outcomes & appraisal cards specifically design for pre primary level were shared in detail.



Administrative and Operational Initiatives



- **Revamping of Examination system** – Principal Mr. Ashish Sawhney conducted a firsthand inspection of the examination system particularly question paper drafting and assessment methods for all offline examinations (both Unit -1 and Unit -2). Based on the same a critical review was shared with the staff members in staff meetings and points for consideration were shared in minutes of meetings as well.
- In consideration of these observations, it has been decided to separate internal and external examination department for Unit -2 and create an examination department in Unit -1. These decisions are also in line with the guidance from **School Advisory Council**.
- **Setting up of Examination and Timetable department in Unit -1**. Recommendations from HM's and self nominations by the teachers have been sought to select the right candidates. Final decision will be taken in consultation with HM's and it is sought to make these departments fully operational by January end.
- Concept of **Student Council**, which was dysfunctional since 2015-16, to be introduced again in Unit -2 from the academic session 2022-23.
- Unit -1, which did not have student council concept since its inception, to have a **separate student council** from academic session 2022-23.
