

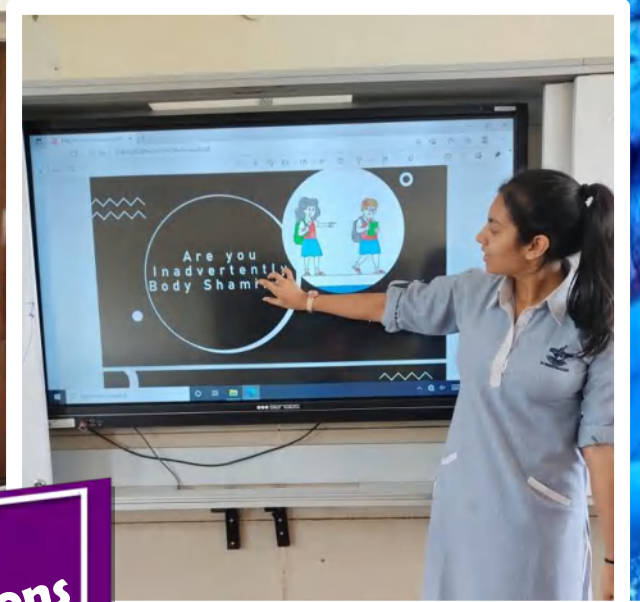

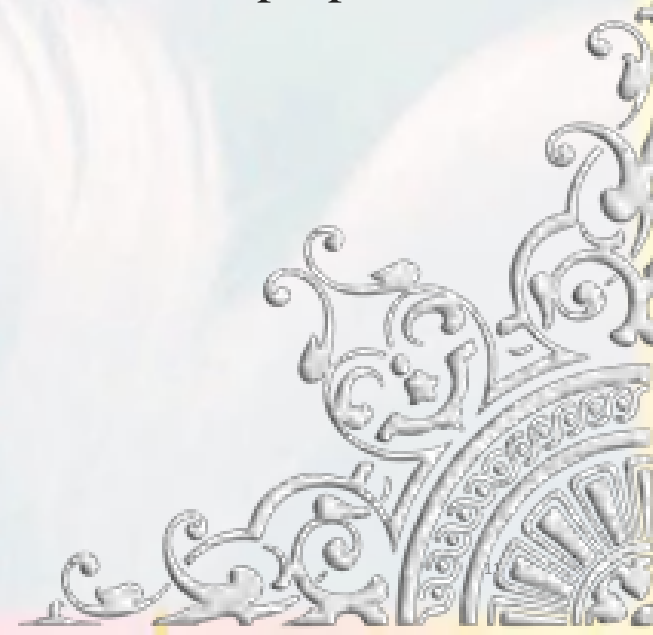

A lightning strike is almost 5 times hotter than the surface of the sun.

Lightning is a very quick electrical discharge that occurs between a cloud and the ground, between two clouds, or within a cloud.

Lightning happens when the negative charges (electrons) in the bottom of the cloud are attracted to the positive charges (protons) in the ground.

It can be seen as bright flash and is followed by the sound of thunder.



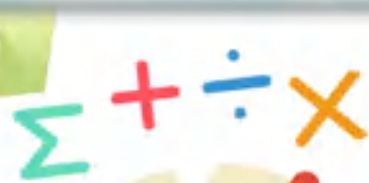
We see the lightning before we hear the thunder. As light travels much faster than sound waves. Light travels about 3,00,000 Km per second.
