**(from 23 July 2022 – 25 Sept 2022)**

- The period of this report covers the first time after pandemic that the school and all the stakeholders were clear that there would be no further disruptions to regular school.
- Hence, the entire scope of planned activities were implemented at all levels in the offline mode. During this time we had Unit test concluded, ***19 Inter School, 12 Intra School, 6 Inter House activities 14 Major events***, and ***currently half yearly examinations*** are underway.

A story telling / reading session is conducted once every week for all classes, stories selected involve moral values and with aimed at developing sense of learning, responsibility and widening the imagination of young learners. 




## *Group Discussions by Class XII* *(8 Aug – 16 Aug 2022)*



- Group discussions in the classroom enhance student's critical thinking and communication skills.
- It also helps in educational development as it improves learning. In lieu of it groups discussion were organised for XII Classes from 8th August to 16th August 2022.
- Entire sections of XII were divided into three groups and topics like **'Future of Internet, Fast food culture, No one wins War, Gender based stereotypes** were allotted to them in advance.
- Students participation was overwhelming and the scope of sessions had to be extended.
- A major observation was that students were required to be aware of group discussion etiquettes & accordingly a document title "GD etiquettes – Patience & Timings" is being drafted for students.


# Literary Fest ( English Week )




Class/ Activities	Description
