B. 'Class commencement and Management'. She covered many aspects of this topic like:

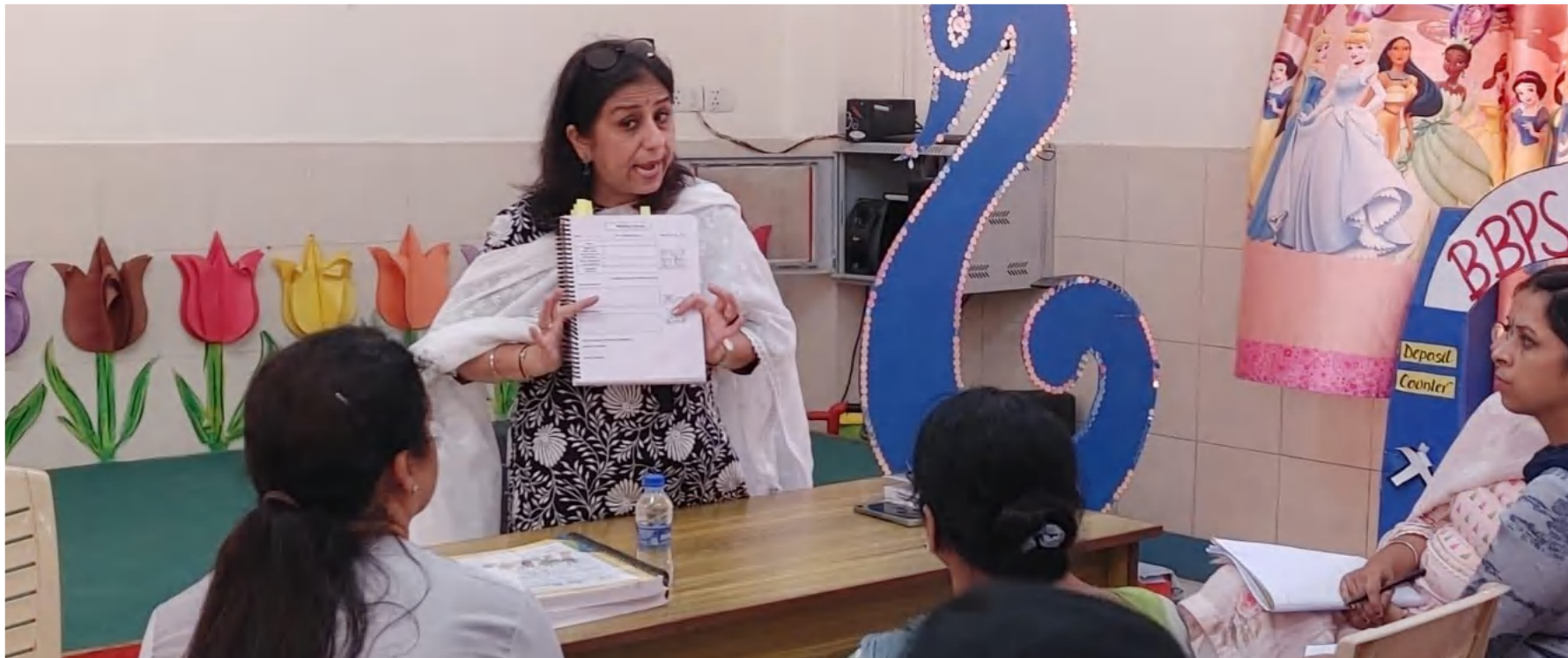
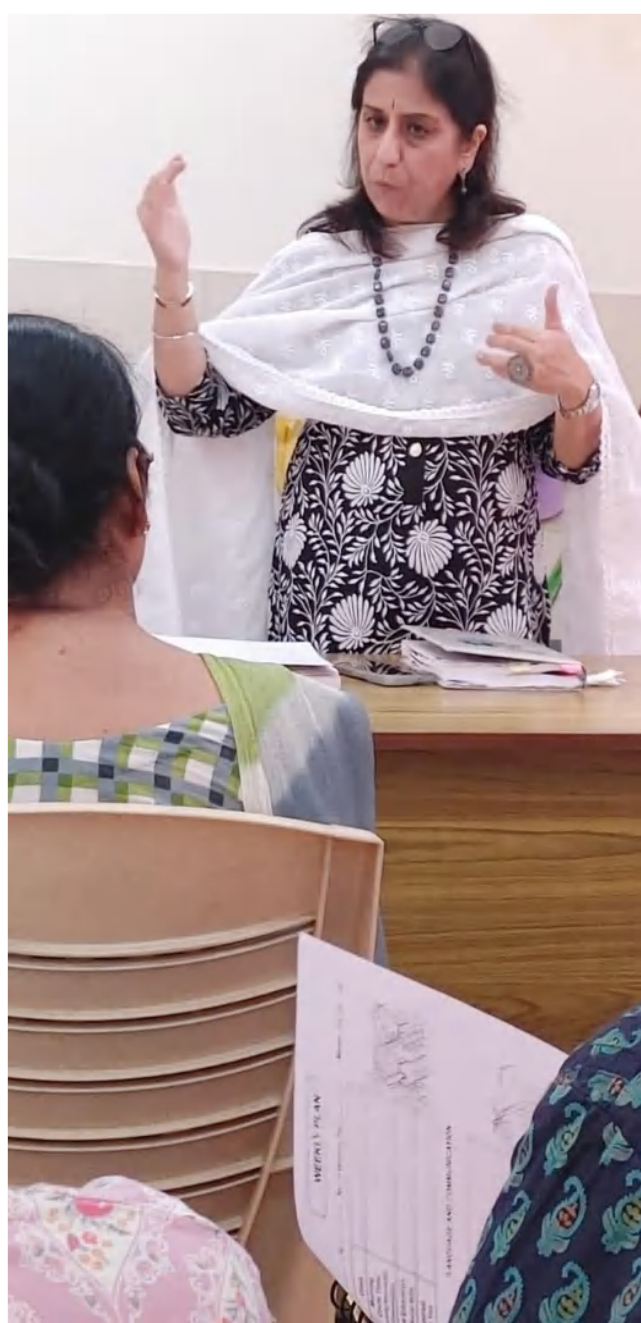
- Decor.
