- 26. How does a joint family differ from a nuclear family?
- Ans. a) Family in which only parents and children live together is called a nuclear family.
 - b) Grandparents, parents, siblings (brother and sister), uncles, aunts and cousins live together in a same house is called a joint family. It is bigger than a nuclear family.
