Activity 1 : "My Story Character Puppet".

Instructions:

Read any story and choose your favourite character from the story.

2. Gather Materials:

*Coloured paper or cardstock. , *Markers, crayons, or coloured pencils.

*Scissors, *Glue or tape, *Craft sticks, wooden skewers, or straws for stick puppets, *Googly eyes, yarn, glitter, or other decorative items.

3. Design the Puppet:

Cut out shapes: Cut out the shapes of the characters from the coloured paper or cardstock. Start with simple shapes like ovals for heads or rectangles for bodies. Draw or colour their facial features, clothing, and any other details you want to add.

4. Record the video :

After making puppet, students will speak few sentences on their favourite story character using its puppet and record the video. Students will upload their videos in the link given below.
